An Act of the Parliament of the Cook Islands to appropriate certain sums of money out of the Cook Islands Government Account to the services of the Financial year ending with the Thirty-first day of March 1990 and to amend the Appropriation Act 1989

(23 March 1990)

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN, - We, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Parliament of the Cook Islands towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this year, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it enacted by the Parliament of the Cook Islands in Session assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and application - This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Amendment Act 1989-90, and applies to the year ending on Thirty-first day of March 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Appropriation Act 1989 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

2. Grant and appropriation out of the Cook Islands Government Account - Subsection (1) of Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the amount of \$42,976,000 and substituting the amount of \$46,032,100.

3. Schedule - The principal Act is hereby further amended by deleting the Schedule and substituting the following Schedule:
