AN ACT TO AUTHORISE APPROPRIATION OF MONIES OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR RECURRENT EXPENDITURE FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING 31 DECEMBER 2004

Commencement: 2004

MADE by the Maneaba ni Maungatabu and assented to by Te Beretitenti.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (No.2) Act 2003 and shall come into operation on 1 January 2004.

Authorisation of issue of \$83,485,139 from the Consolidated Fund

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$83,485,139 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending 31 December 2004.

Appropriation

3. The sum specified in section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule.

Transfer of functions

4. Where after the commencement of this Act and before 1st January 2005 a function is transferred from one Ministry to another the authority conferred by sections 2 and 3 to issue and apply monies out of the Consolidated Fund extends to the issue and application of monies in respect of that function by that other Ministry.
