AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE CERTAIN SUMS TO THE RECURRENT SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING ON 31 DECEMBER 1982

Commencement: 1 January, 1982

Short title.

1.

This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1981.

Authorisation of issue of \$15,704,163 from the Consolidated Fund.

Appropriation.

Transfer of functions.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of fifteen million, seven hundred and four thousand, one hundred and sixty three dollars to be applied to the recurrent service of the year ending on 31 December 1982.

3. The sum specified in Section 2 shall be appropriated for the purposes of the Heads of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively set forth in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule

4. Where after the commencement of this Act and before 1st January 1983, a function is transferred from one Ministry to another, the authority conferred by Sections 1 and 2 to issue and apply monies out of the Consolidated Fund extends to the issue and application of monies in respect of that function by that other Ministry.
