

AN ACT TO AMEND THE HIGH COURT JUDGES (SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES) ACT 2017.

## 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the High Court Judges (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act 2021.

## 2. Meaning of Principal Act

In this Act the Principal Act means the High Court Judges (Salaries and Allowances) Act 2017.

### 3. Amendment of Section 5

Section 5 is amended as follows:

- (a) In section 5(2) by repealing the whole subsection and substituting it with the following;
  - "5(2) (a). The appointment of a judge must be made on a fixed term specified which may be extended where deemed necessary. This applies to new and existing judges.
  - (b). Where the appointment was made for a fixed period, the appointment may be further extended until the appointee is 65 years old or beyond upon production of a satisfactory medical report".
  - (c). Where the appointee is over 65 years when first appointed, the appointment made for a fixed period, may also be extended upon production of a satisfactory medical report".

### **Explanatory Memorandum**

The main purpose of this Act is to amend section 5 of the principal Act on the tenure of offices of the judges. The insertion of a new subsection 5(2)(a) provides generally for the appointment of new and existing judges which must be on a fixed term period. Subsection 5(2)(b) specifically covers the appointment of judges under 65 years old during the period of appointment which may be extended until 65 years old or beyond upon production of a satisfactory medical report. Subsection 5(2)(c) on the other hand further provides for those judges who are already 65 year old on first appointment which may also be extended upon production of a satisfactory medical report.


