AN ACT TO AUTHORISE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION OF MONIES CUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR RECURRENT EXPENDITURE FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING 31ST DECEMBER 1984.

Short title

Authorisation of issue of \$65,000.00 from the Consolidated Fund.

Appropriation

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act (No. 1) 1984.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of sixty five thousand dollars (\$65,000.00) to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending 31st December 1984.

3. The sum specified in Section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the Head of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sum respectively specified in relation thereto in column 2 of the Schedule.

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION ACT (No. 1) 1984

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. This Act charges upon the Consolidated Fund a sum which is required for recurrent expenditure for the year ending 31st December 1984, in addition to the amount appropriated for that year by the Appropriation Act 1983.
- 2. The sum required is to provide for money expended in excess of sums already appropriated.
- 3. The Act provides that the additional amount charged shall be expended upon the service listed in the Schedule to the Act.
- 4. The Act was presented to the Maneaba ni Maungatabu in accordance with the requirements of Section 109(3) of the Constitution.
