Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act 1995 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 November 1994.

Authorisation of issue of \$630,000 from the Consolidated Fund

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$630,000 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending December 1994.

Appropriation

3. The sum specified in Section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule.
