1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act 1995.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$1,440,788 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending 31 December 1995.

Appropriation

3. The sum specified in Section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of Heads of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule.
