1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act 1983.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$533,384.00 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending 31st December 1982.

Appropriation.

3. The sum specified in Section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule.

# SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (NO. 2) ACT, 1983

#### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
