AN ACT TO AUTHORISE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION
OF MONIES OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR
RECURRENT EXPENDITURE FOR THE SERVICE OF
THE YEAR ENDING 31 DECEMBER 1991

Commencement:

MADE by the Maneaba ni Maungatabu and assented to by the Beretitenti.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Approxiation Act 1991.

Authorisation of issue of \$271,178 from the Consolidated Fund

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$271,178 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending 31 December 1991.

Appropriation

3. The sum specified in Section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule.

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION ACT 1991

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. This Act charges upon the Consolidated Fund a sum, which is required for recurrent expenditure for the year ending 31 December 1991, in addition to the amount appropriated for that year by the Appropriation Act 1990.
- 2. The sums required is to provide for money expended in excess of sums already appropriated.
- 3. The Act provides that the additional amount charged shall be expended upon the service listed in the Schedule to the Act.
- 4. The Act is presented to the Maneaba ni Maungatabu in accordance with the requirements of Section 109(3) of the Constitution.
