Authorisation of issue of \$3,155,200 from the Consolidated Fund

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$3,155,200 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending 31 December 1992.

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION ACT, 1992

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. This Act charges upon the Consolidated Fund a sum, which is required for recurrent expenditure for the year ending 31 December 1992, in addition to the amount appropriated for that year by the Appropriation Act 1992.
- 2. The sums required is to provide for money expended in excess of sums already appropriated.
- 3. The Act provides that the additional amount charged shall be expended upon the service listed in the Schedule to the Act.
- 4. The Act is presented to the Maneaba ni Maungatabu in accordance with the requirements of Section 109(3) of the Constitution.
