§303. Iroijlaplap of Enewetak and Ujelang Atolls.

No person holds or may hold any Iroijlaplap rights, titles and Interests in and to Enewetak and Ujelang Atolls other than the successors of Johannes Peter and Binton Abraham, who hold such rights, titles and interests to the extent permitted by, and in accordance with, the customs and traditions of the people of Enewetak.
