THE TERRITORY OF NAURU NO.6⁵OF 1966

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Census Ordinance 1961. Assented to 17 MAY 1966 BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Nauru, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the <u>Nauru Act</u> 1965, as follows:-

Short title and citation. 1.-(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Census Ordinance</u> 1966.

(2.) The <u>Census Ordinance</u> 1961 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the <u>Census Ordinance</u> 1961-1966.

2. Section 13 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:-

Householder's Schedule. "13.(1.) For the purposes of taking and collecting the Census in a census year, a Householder's Schedule shall be prepared specifying the matters in relation to -

(a) a dwelling; and

(b) a person in that dwelling, in respect of which particulars are required to be furnished.

"(2.) For the purposes of the last preceding sub-section the matters in relation to a dwelling are -

(a) the class of dwelling, that is to say, whether the dwelling is a private house, flat, portion of a private house or flat, hotel, institution or other class or habitation; (b) the material of which the outer walls of the dwelling are constructed;

- (c) the number of rooms in the dwelling;
- (d) the title by which the occupier occupies the dwelling;
- (e) the weekly rate of rent (if any) payable in respect of the dwelling;
- (f) whether the dwelling is provided with facilities for the use of gas or electricity or both;
- (g) whether the dwelling contains a kitchen or bathroom or both;
- (h) In the case of a dwelling (other than a boarding house, hospital or other institution), the number of motor vehicles (excluding motor cycles and motor scooters) used by members of the household occupying the dwelling that were garaged or parked at or near the dwelling on the night of the Census day;
- (i) the date of construction of the dwelling;and
- (j) whether the dwelling is on a rural holding of not less than one acre in area.

"(3.) For the purposes of sub-section (1.) of this section, the matters in relation to a person are -

- (a) the name of the person;
- (b) the relation of the person to the headof the household of the dwelling inwhich the person is residing;
- (c) in the case of a person who is not engaged in an industry, business,

profession, trade or service, whether the person is -

- (i) a child who has not attended school;
- (ii) a school child or a full-time student;
- (iii) a person mainly dependent for support on pension or superannuation;
 - (iv) a person of independent means;
 - (v) a person engaged in unpaid home duties;
- (vi) an inmate of an institution; or
- (vii) a person other than a person referred to in the preceding sub-paragraphs of this paragraph;
- (d) in the case of a person usually engaged in an industry, business, profession, trade or service-whether the person was so engaged on the Census day or was unemployed on that day;
- (e) the sex of the person;
- (f) the age of the person on the Census day;
- (g) whether the person is married and, if so, the duration of that marriage;
 - (h) in the case of a person whose marriage is existing on the Census day - the number of children (if any) of that person and the spouse of that person born to them '
 - during that marriage;
 - (i) the religion of the person;
 - (j) the place at which the person was born;
 - (k) in the case of a person who was not
 born in the Territory the period
 during which he has resided in the
 Territory;
- (1) the nationality of the person;
- (m) the race to which the person belongs;

- (n) the highest level of schooling completed by the person;
- (o) the qualifications or training of the person for a profession or occupation, whether or not the person was engaged in that profession or occupation on the Census day;
- (p) in the case of a person who has attained the age of fifteen years -
 - (i) whether the person was employed or engaged in an industry, business, profession, trade or service in the week that ended on the Saturday before the Census day;
 - (ii)whether the person performed any work
 or rendered any service for payment or
 profit in the week that ended on the
 Saturday before the Census day;
 - (iii)if the person is an employee, whether the person was temporarily laid off work by his employer without pay for the whole of the week that ended on the Saturday before Census day;
 - (iv)if the person was not employed in the week that ended on the Saturday before the Census day, whether the person endeavoured to obtain employ-ment in that week;
 - (v) if the person was an employee during the week that ended on the Saturday before the Census day, the number of hours per week usually worked by the person as such an employee;

- (vi) whether the person is an employee in receipt of salary or wages or whether the person is engaged in an industry, business, profession, trade or service carried on on his own behalf;
- (vii) whether the person is an employer;
- (viii) whether the person helps in the carrying on of an industry, business, profession, trade or service and does not receive wages or salary;
 - (ix) whether the person has never previously
 been employed and is seeking employment
 for the first time;
 - (x) the occupation, industry, business,
 profession, trade or service in which
 the person was employed or engaged
 during the week that ended on the
 Saturday before the Census day;
 - (xi) in the case of an employee the full name of the employer and the address at which the employee is employed;
- (xii) in the case of a person who carries on an industry, business, profession, trade or service on his own behalf the name under which, and the address at which he carries on the industry, business, profession, trade or service; and
- (xiii) in the case of a person who helps in the carrying on of an industry, business, profession, trade or service and does not receive salary or wages the name under which, and the address at which, the industry, business, profession, trade or service is carried on.".

Persons may be required to furnish particulars.

3. Section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (b) of sub-section (1.) the words "the Act" and inserting in their stead the words "this Ordinance".

Amendments in relation to decimal currency. 4. The Principal Ordinance is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance.
