AN

ORDINANCE

## To amend the Licences Amendment Ordinance 1922-1935

BE it ordained by the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, acting in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 1 of the Agreement dated the second day of July, 1919, between His Majesty's Government in London, His Majesty's Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, and His Majesty's Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, as follows:-

Short title.

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Licences Ordinance 1939.
- (2) The <u>Licences Amendment Ordinance</u> 1922-1935 is, in this Ordinance, referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the <u>Licences Ordinance</u> 1922-1939.

Operation.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the twenty-sixth day of August One thousand nine hundred and thirtynine.

Amendment.

3. The Principal Ordinance is amended by adding after Section 18 the following Section:-

"18A PIGS.

No person is permitted to keep a boar over the age of three months unless a Licence is obtained and a Licence Fee of £5. O. O. per annum is paid. In all cases, before a Licence is issued, the owner must submit the boar for inspection by the Administrator or other Officer deputed by the Administrator.

Penalty for any breach of this Section: Fine not exceeding £10, 0. 0, or imprisonment for one month, with or without hard labour, or both."
