1961, No. 11

An Ordinance to regulate the Public Holidays on Niue
(13 April 1961).

1. Short Title - This Ordinance may be cited as the Niue Island Public Holidays Ordinance 1961.
2. Days observed as Public Holidays - The following days shall be observed as Public Holidays on the Island of Niue:
