### Loan (Electricity) Act 1976,

Being an Act to allow the Government to borrow a certain amount of money and to spend it for the purpose of the development of electricity supply works.

#### 1. AUTHORITY TO BORROW.

The State may borrow, in accordance with the *Loans Securities Act 1960*, up to K400,000.00, less any amounts borrowed before 1 January 1976 (the effective date for the purposes of the *Revision of the Laws Act* 1973 (Adopted)) under the Act listed in Schedule 1.

#### 2. PURPOSES FOR WHICH MONEY MAY BE SPENT.

Moneys borrowed under this Act may be spent only-

- (a) for the expenses of borrowing; and
- (b) for the purpose of development of electricity supply works.
