AMENDMENT OF BUILDING REGULATIONS.(1) Statutory Rules.

No. 1 of 1949.

1. Sub-regulation (2) of regulation 8 of the Building Regulations⁽²⁾ is hereby repealed.

(a) These Regulations stated in their introductory part that they were "to come into operation for thwith.". At the relevant dates in 1949 the *Public Health Ordinance* 1932-1938 (under which these Regulations were made) made no provision as to the date of commencement of regulations made thereunder, but Section 37 (1) of the Ordinances Interpretation Ordinance 1949 of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea provided that "Regulations . . . made . . . under an Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears in the Ordinance—

(a) shall be published in the Gazette; and
(b) shall . . . take effect from the date of publication, or where another date is specified in the regulations, from the date specified.".
At the relevant dates in 1949, there was no Ordinance or regulation of general application providing for the meaning of "forthwith".

2. Regulation 9 of the *Building Regulations*⁽²⁾ is hereby repealed and the following new regulation inserted in its stead:—

"9. The Board for the Town of Rabaul (the Rabaul Building Board) shall consist of three members who shall be—

the Officer for the time being administering the District of New Britain, who shall be Chairman of the Board; and the Senior Medical Officer stationed at Rabaul; and George Ian MacLennan.".
