SUPPLY ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1951-52.⁽¹⁾

No. 29 of 1951.

An Ordinance to grant and apply out of the Public Revenue a sum for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.

B E it ordained by the Administrator of the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua and New Guinea Act 1949-1950, as follows:--

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supply Ordinance short title. (No. 2) 1951-52.⁽¹⁾

2. Subject to authorization from the Administrator, the $\frac{\text{Grant of }}{\text{22,000,00}}$ Treasurer may issue out of the Public Revenue and apply for the service of the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, the sum of two million pounds.

3. The sum granted by this Ordinance is additional to the sum Appropriation. granted by the Supply Ordinance (No. 1) $1951-52^{(2)}$ and is appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Ordinance in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.

4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have taken effect from Date of commencement. the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.

THE SCHEDULE.

ADVANCE TO THE TREASURER.

To enable the Treasurer to make advances to public officers and to meet annual expenditure for the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, particulars of which afterwards will be included in an Appropriation Ordinance.
