CEMETERIES REGULATIONS.(1)

REGULATIONS 1936, No. 3.

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Cemeteries Regulations. (1)

Definitions.

- 2.—(1.) In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—
 - "Ordinance" means the Cemeteries Ordinance 1935.(2)
- (2.) Any reference in these Regulations to a form shall be read as a reference to a form in the First Schedule to these Regulations.

Fees.

3. The fees to be charged under the Ordinance shall be as set out in the Second Schedule to these Regulations.

Dimensions of burial allotments. 4. The dimensions of the burial allotments into which the cemetery authority may, under section 11 of the Ordinance, divide the cemetery shall be $2\frac{1}{2}$ metres in length and $1\frac{1}{2}$ metres in width.

Period for which burial allotments may be reserved. 5. Subject to the provisions of section 13 of the Ordinance, a cemetery authority may, for the burial of deceased persons other than natives within a cemetery, reserve to an applicant the right to burial allotments during a period of twenty years.

Form of certificate of reservation of right to burial allotments.

6. A certificate of a reservation of a right to burial allotments shall be in accordance with Form 1.

Form of notification by a cemetery authority of a burial in a cemetery. 7. Where a burial is carried out in a cemetery, the cemetery authority shall notify the District Registrar of the burial in accordance with Form 2.

Form of notification by a cemetery authority of a burial in a private burial ground.

8. Where a cemetery authority gives his consent to a burial in any land the subject of a licence under section 8 of the Ordinance, he shall notify the District Registrar in accordance with Form 3.

Notification by licensee of a burial in a private burial ground. 9. Where a burial is carried out in any land the subject of a licence under section 8 of the Ordinance, the licensee shall notify the District Registrar of the burial in accordance with Form 4.
