DOG ORDINANCE 1925.(1)

No. 30 of 1925.

An Ordinance to repeal certain Ordinances relating to Dogs, and for other purposes.

B E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia. with the advice of the Federal Executive of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the New Guinea Act 1920, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dog Ordinance 1925.(1) shortstile.
- 2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the commencement, first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twentythree.
- 3. The Dog Ordinance 1916 and the Dog (Amendment) Repeal. Ordinance 1919 are hereby repealed:

Provided that nothing in this Ordinance shall affect the validity of any registration made under those Ordinances prior to the commencement of this Ordinance.

4. Regulations 1, and 3 to 19 inclusive, of the Dog Regulations Validation of 1923,(2) and the Schedules to those Regulations, shall be deemed to be as valid and effectual as if this Ordinance had been in force at the date upon which it is deemed to have commenced.
