FUGITIVE OFFENDERS (JURISDICTION) ORDINANCE 1927.⁽¹⁾

No. 11 of 1927.

An Ordinance to confer on the Central Court⁽²⁾ jurisdiction under the Fugitive Offenders Act 1881 of the United Kingdom.

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the New Guinea Act 1920-1926 as follows :----

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fugitive Offenders short title. (Jurisdiction) Ordinance 1927.⁽¹⁾

2. The jurisdiction under Part I. of the Fugitive Offenders Act Central Court 1881⁽³⁾ of the United Kingdom (44 and 45 Vic. C. 69) to hear a jurisdiction. case and commit a fugitive to prison to await his return shall be exercised in the Territory of New Guinea by the Central Court⁽²⁾ of the Territory.
