SEAMEN'S COMPENSATION ORDINANCE 1924-1925.⁽¹⁾

An Ordinance to amend the Seamen's Compensation Act 1911 of the Commonwealth of Australia in its application to the Territory of New Guinea.

E it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the New Guinea Act 1920, as follows:--

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Seamen's Compensation Short title. Ordinance 1924-1925.(1)
- 2. Section seventeen of the Seamen's Compensation Act 1911 (2) of the Commonwealth of Australia in its application to the Territory of New Guinea is amended by omitting the word "Governor-General" and inserting in its stead the word." Administrator".(3)
- 3. In the application to the Territory of the Seamen's Compensation Act 1911 any reference to a County Court shall be read as a reference to the Central Court (4) of the Territory.
