

PROCLAMATIONS MADE PURSUANT TO SECTION 9 OF THE ANIMALS PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION ORDINANCE, 1911.

Particulars of these proclamations (and of proclamations made under the *Diseased Animals Act*, (Queensland, adopted) and *The Animals Restriction Ordinance of 1907*, which are continued in force by the *Animals Prohibition and Restriction Ordinance, 1911*) are set out in the Table below, and the proclamations still in force are printed immediately after the Table:—

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency JOHN HUBERT PLUNKETT MURRAY, Acting Administrator of the Territory of Papua.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance, No. 15 of 1907, intituled "*The Animals Restriction Ordinance of 1907*," it is enacted that the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, may prohibit the introduction of any animal into the Territory of Papua. Now, therefore, I, the Acting Administrator aforesaid, with the

advice of the Executive Council of the Territory, and in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the said Ordinance, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, do hereby, from the date of this my Proclamation, prohibit and forbid, except by the consent in writing, under the hand of the Lieutenant-Governor—

The landing or introduction into the Territory of any animal from any place other than the Commonwealth of Australia and New Zealand.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the said Territory, this eighth day of September, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eight, and in the eighth year of His Majesty's reign.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance intituled the *Animals Prohibition and Restriction Ordinance, 1911*, it is amongst other things enacted that the Lieutenant-Governor may, from time to time, with the advice of the Executive Council, by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, prohibit or put restrictions on the removal of any animals or of any one or more kind of animals from any one portion of the Territory to any other portion of the Territory:

Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor aforesaid, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the said Ordinance, do hereby proclaim and declare that the removal of any bull, cow, ox, or the young of any such

animal, to those portions of the Territory described in the Schedule hereto from any other portion of the Territory shall be prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

All that portion between the Main Range and the North-East Coast from latitude 8° 00' S. to East Cape except the area within a radius of two miles of the Government Station at Tufi. Also the following Islands: d'Entrecasteaux Group, Trobriand Island Group, Doini Island, Woodlark Island, Misima Island, Nivani Island, Rossel Island.

any other portion of the Territory shall be prohibited except by the consent in writing under the hand of the Lieutenant-Governor.

WHEREAS by the *Animals Prohibition and Restriction Ordinance, 1911*, it is among other things enacted that the Lieutenant-Governor may, from time to time with the advice of the Executive Council by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, prohibit or put restrictions on the introduction or importation of any animals or of any one or more kind of animals into the Territory:

Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor aforesaid, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the powers in me vested, do hereby proclaim and declare that the introduction or importation of Alsatian dogs into the Territory is prohibited.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the said Territory, this sixteenth day of May, in the year of Our Lord, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, and in the twenty-third year of His Majesty's reign.
