An Ordinance to amend the "Customs Tariff, 1934."

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua Act, 1905-1934, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Tariff, $1936.^{(1)}$

(2.) The Customs Tariff, 1934, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Tariff, 1934-1936.⁽²⁾

2. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance except as to anything done before the commencement of this Ordinance and except so far as may be necessary for the purpose of supporting or continuing any proceeding heretofore taken or to be taken after the commencement of this Ordinance and any article declared free of duty shall be deemed to be free in accordance with the said Second Schedule as so amended.

3. Where by this Ordinance any article is declared free the article declared free of duty shall be deemed to have been free as on and from the twentieth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, at Ten o'clock in the forenoon declared according to standard time in force in the Territory of Papua and this Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation at that time.
