QUARANTINE (PREVENTION OF ACUTE ANT-ERIOR POLIOMYELITIS) REGULATIONS, 1937. (1)

Statutory Rules.

No. 5 of 1937.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Prevention of Acute Anterior Poliomyelitis) Regulations, 1937. (1)
- 2. When any person under the age of twenty-one years enters the Territory after the commencement of these regulations having been within the State of Victoria a place infected with acute anterior poliomyelitis at any time during a period of three weeks prior to such entry such person shall until the expiration of three weeks from the time he left the said State be subject to such medical supervision and control as the Quarantine Officer at the port of entry may require.
- 3. The parent or guardian of any person subject to the preceding regulation may be required to give an undertaking that he will be responsible for the due observance of the requirements of such regulation.
- 4. Any person subject to Regulation Two hereof who without reasonable excuse proof whereof shall be upon him neglects or refuses to comply with the requirements of the said Quarantine Officer shall be guilty of an offence against these regulations and liable upon summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Ten pounds.
- 5. Any parent or guardian who has given an undertaking in accordance with the provisions of Regulation Three hereof shall be liable to a penalty of not exceeding Fifty pounds recoverable summarily upon conviction of a breach of these regulations of the person for whom he is responsible unless such parent or guardian satisfies the Court that he has taken every reasonable precaution to prevent a breach of these regulations.
