If successful, K100 would have to be paid in this case. The highest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted.

Fees.—All tenders and applications must be accompanied by an application fee of Two Kina (K2.00) for each portion or allotment required. Following the grant of a lease an additional fee for the preparation of lease document, the amount of tender less the upset price where applicable and, it surveyed, the prescribed survey fee shall be payable within two (2) months from the date of grant.

Preference.—Tenderers and applicants are advised to indicate preferences if there are more than one allotment or portion being advertised in any particular advertisement, but only one registration of application fee need be lodged if only one allotment or portion is required. If more than one allotment or portion is required, an additional fee for each such portion or allotment must be lodged.

Tenderers and Applicants.—Tenderers and Applicants must state full name, occupation and postal address. Applicants and Tenderers will be required to produce to the Land Board acceptable evidence as to possession of suitable experience and/or financial resources, as the case may be, for the development of the land.
