PRICES ORDER No. 148

being

A PRICES ORDER relating to the maximum retail price for

POULTRY

MADE by the Price Controller under the provisions of the Prices Regulation Act 1949, as amended to date, to come into operation on the date of publication in the Government Gazette.

1. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order-

- "poultry" means fresh or frozen dressed and packaged chickens produced in Papua New Guinea.
- "supplier" in relation to poultry, means a person or a firm who sells poultry for the purpose of consumption or use.

"retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

2. MAXIMUM PRICE.

(a) The maximum price per bird at which poultry may be sold by retail in the cities of Port Moresby and Lae is the amount specified in Column 2 of the Schedule in relation to the size of each bird specified opposite in Column 1 of the Schedule.

(b) The maximum price per bird at which poultry may be sold by retail at locations other than the cities of Port Moresby and Lae is the price fixed in accordance with Subclause (a) of this Clause, plus the transport charge actually incurred (if any) in respect of such poultry from the producer or wholesaler from whom it was purchased to the supplier's store, plus an amount equal to five *per centum* of that charge.

3. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or organisation who has in his custody or under his control any poultry to which this Order applies, for sale by retail, or who offers, exhibits or exposes any of that poultry for sale by retail, shall display a ticket, label, placard or notice attached to or exhibited or displayed with that poultry setting forth in a clear prominent position in clear and legible figures, easily discernible to any person inspecting such poultry, the price at which the poultry concerned may be bought.

PRICES ORDER No. 149

A PRICES ORDER relating to the maximum retail price for-

PETROL, DISTILLATE AND LIGHTING KEROSENE

MADE by the Deputy Price Controller under the provisions of the Prices Regulation Act 1949, as amended to date, to come into operation on the date of publication in the Government Gazette.

1. CITATION.

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 149.

2. REVOCATION.

The Prices Orders specified in Schedule 2 of this Order are revoked.

3. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order-

"petrol" includes any substance normally sold as petrol whether or not containing additives of any kind;

- "distillate" includes any substance normally sold as automotive distillate whether or not containing additives of any kind;
- "kerosene" includes any substance normally sold as kerosene being a medium refined petroleum product as used for lighting and cooking in home appliances, whether or not containing additives of any kind;
- "wholesaler" in relation to petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene for the purpose of resale and not for the purpose of use;
- "supplier" in relation to petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene, means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene for the purpose of use;

"retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

4. MAXIMUM PRICE.

(i) Subject to Sub-Clause (ii) of this Clause, where petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene is supplied-

- (a) at a locality specified in the first Column of Schedule 1 to this Order; or
- (b) at some other place at which the petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene is transported from any such locality by or on behalf of a wholesaler or supplier;

the maximum price per gallon at which the petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene may be supplied is the sum of-

- (c) the maximum retail selling price specified in the Second, Third or Fourth Column as the case may be, of Schedule 1 in relation to the locality concerned; and
- (d) the amount (if any) charged for the transport referred to in paragraph (b) of this Sub-Clause.

(ii) Where the maximum price of any quantity of petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene supplied at any one time, calculated in accordance with Sub-Clause (i) of this Clause is an amount involving a fraction of a toea, the supplier may charge to the next whole toea.

5. SUPPLY TO GOVERNMENT ETC.

Nothing in this Order applies to or relates to the supply of petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene to the Government, Australia or a Statutory Authority of the Government or Australia.

6. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or an organisation engaged in selling petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene by retail shall display in each of the places of business in prominent positions and in large, clear and legible figures the maximum prices at which such petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene may be bought.

Terms and Conditions-

1. An applicant must-

- (a) be engaged or about to be engaged solely in the business of operating private hire cars or public hire cars, as the case may be, or in that business and some other business jointly with it;
- (b) be a person of good characters;
- (c) be a fit and proper person to hold a Certificate of Registration; and
- (d) when required, furnish evidence to the Commissioner of Police as to the provisions of paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) hereof.
- 2. Applicants must, in their application-
 - (a) state their reasons for requiring the grant of a certificate of registration;
 - (b) give details of the matter referred to in paragraph
 (a) of condition one hereof;
 - (c) fully document the economic viability of their proposal;
 - (d) state the make and model of vehicles proposed for registration; and
 - (e) where equity in the business is not wholly Papua New Guinean, state the full details of the company share-holding structure including the basis on which Papua New Guinean equity is being established.

3. Applications may be objected to by the Commissioner of Police and rejected by the Board on the ground that the applicant does not comply with one or more of the matters referred to in condition one hereof.

4. In the event of an objection to an application by the Commissioner of Police, the applicant will be given notice of the objection and the grounds therefore and will be afforded an opportunity to be heard on the objections.

5. Where a Certificate of Registration is granted to an applicant who is about to be engaged solely in the business of operating private hire cars or public hire cars or in that business jointly with some other business, and that applicant does not so engage within a reasonable time after the grant the Commissioner of Police may cancel the Certificate of Registration.

6. Applications must be in duplicate, enclosed in an envelope endorsed "Application-Private Hire Car Licence" and addressed to reach the Executive Officer, Passenger Transport Control Board, P.O. Box 3744, Port Moresby, by no later than Wednesday, 1st October, 1975.
