### **DETERMINATION AS TO NUMBER OF MINISTERS**

#### CONSTITUTION

#### AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, Michael Thomas Somare, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148(1) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby amend the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers dated 5th February, 1976 and published in *National Gazette* No. G15 of 13th February, 1976 by inserting after Schedule 21 the following Schedules:—

All the matters related to the functions of the Ministry of Education relating to Culture and Recreation as are delegated by the Minister for Education.".
