REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS DISTRICT EDUCATION BOARD

I, Kobale Kale, Minister for Education, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 44 and 48 of the Education

(Papua New Guinea) Act 1970 and all other powers me enabling, hereby-

- (a) revoke the Notice of Appointment of Members and Alternate Members of the Southern Highlands District Education Board dated 27th September, 1976 and published in National Gazette No. G83 of 14th October, 1976, in so far as it relates to the appointment of Charles Oaeke and Joseph Keviame as Members of the Southern Highlands District Education Board; and
- (b) revoke the Notice of Appointment of Member of the Southern Highlands District Education Board dated 15th November, 1976 and published in National Gazette No. G95 of 2nd December, 1976, relating to the appointment of Regina Kati as a Member of the Southern Highlands District Education Board; and
- (c) appoint Tau Raka to be the Alternate Member for Bob Angoun, a Member appointed under Section 44(2)(e) of that Act; and
- (d) appoint each person specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to be a member of the Southern Highlands District Education Board-
 - (i) under that section of the Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule opposite the name of that person; and
 - (ii) to hold office for the period specified in Column 3 of the Schedule opposite the name of that person; and
- (e) appoint each person specified in Column 4 of the Schedule to be the Alternate Member of the Member whose name is set out in Column 1 opposite the name of the Alternate Member.
