Animal Disease and Control Act 1952

RESTRICTION ON IMPORTATION AND INTRODUCTION OF POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS

I, Julius Chan, Minister for Primary Industry, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 21(a) of the Animal Disease and Control Act 1952, and all other powers me enabling, hereby prohibit the introduction or importation into Papua New Guinea of all cage birds, fertile eggs and newly hatched young of domesticated poultry originating from Australia and poultry of all kinds (including poultry products and eggs of poultry) originating in the Australian State of Queensland, except with the approval of the Chief Quarantine Officer (Animals).
