PROPOSED LAW TO ALTER THE ORGANIC LAW ON THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT OF JUDGES

Terms and Conditions of Employment of Judges (Amendment No. 1) Law,

Being a Law to alter the Organic Law on the Terms and Conditions of Employment of Judges by raising, and providing for the raising of, the retiring age of Judges of the National Court,

MADE by the National Parliament.

RETIREMENT (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 7).

Section 7 of the Principal Law is amended-

- (a) by omitting from Subsection (1) "the age of 55 years" (twice occurring) and substituting "the age of 60 years"; and
- (b) by omitting Subsection (2) and substituting—
 - "(2) The Judicial and Legal Services Commission may, in its deliberate judgement, in a particular case, extend the retiring age specified in Subsection (1) to, but not beyond, 65 years.".
