Liquor (Licensing) Act 1963

REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE LIQUOR LICENSING COMMISSION FOR THE WESTERN HIGHLANDS PROVINCE

I, Nahau Kambuou Rooney, Minister for Corrective Institutions and Liquor Licensing, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(2)(b) of the Liquor (Licensing) Act 1963 and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

- (a) revoke all previous appointments of members of the Liquor Licensing Commission for the Western Highlands Province; and
- (b) appoint Patrick Gaiyer and Wamp Wan to be Members of the Commission for the Western Highlands Province,

to come into effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*. Dated this 29th day of September, 1978.

Liquor (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1973

DECLARATION OF PUBLIC PLACES

I, Nahau Kambuou Rooney, Minister for Corrective Institutions and Liquor Licensing, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the *Liquor (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act* 1973 and all other powers me enabling, declare all public places in the Western Highlands Province (other than premises which are the subject of a licence or permit under the *Liquor (Licensing) Act* 1963) to be public places to which the provisions of Section 9 of the Act apply.

Liquor (Licensing) Act 1963

RESTRICTION OF SALE AND SUPPLY OF LIQUOR

I, Nahau Kambuou Rooney, Minister for Corrective Institutions and Liquor Licensing, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 31 of the *Liquor (Licensing) Act* 1963 and all other powers me enabling, hereby restrict the sale or supply of liquor throughout the Western Highlands Province under a storekeeper's licence or bottleshop licence for a period of two months commencing on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
