National Investment and Development Act 1974

NOTIFICATION OF APPROVAL OF REGISTRATION

IT is hereby notified in accordance with Section 54(12) of the National Investment and Development Act 1974 that—

(a) under Sections 54(9) and 56(10) of the Act the Minister approved the registration of Halla Cement (PNG) Pty Limited (in this notification called "the Enterprise") in respect of the following activities:

 - (c) The registration shall cease if without the consent of NIDA the Enterprise has not completed within nine months of the date of registration all arrangements and agreements on all matters necessary for the project to proceed. Such matters will include:

(d) The registration shall cease if without the consent of NIDA the Enterprise has not commenced site works within twelve months of the date of registration.

- (e) The registration shall cease if without the consent of NIDA the Enterprise has not commenced production within thirty-six months of the date of registration.
