# PRICES ORDER No. 239

# being

A Prices Order relating to the maximum retail price for

# AVIATION GASOLENE

MADE by the Deputy Price Controller under the provisions of the Prices Regulation Act 1949, to come into operation on the date of publication in the National Gazette.

### 1. CITATION.

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 239.

## 2. REVOCATION.

Prices Order No. 227 is hereby revoked.

#### 3. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order-

"aviation gasolene" includes any substance normally sold as aviation gasolene whether or not containing additives of any kind;

"supplier" in relation to aviation gasolene, means a person or a firm who sells aviation gasolene for the purpose of consumption or use;

"retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

#### 4. MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICE.

- (i) Where aviation gasolene is supplied at a locality specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1, the maximum price at which the aviation gasolene may be supplied is the maximum retail selling price specified in Column 2 of that Schedule in relation to the locality concerned; and
- (ii) Where the maximum price of any quantity of aviation gasolene, supplied at any one time, calculated in accordance with Subclause (i) is an amount involving a fraction of a toea, the supplier may charge to the next whole toea; and
- (iii) Where aviation gasolene is supplied at a locality specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2, the maximum surcharge for each aircraft, specified in Column 2 of that Schedule in relation to the locality concerned may be charged by the supplier in addition to the maximum retail selling price specified in Subclause (i).

#### 5. SUPPLY TO GOVERNMENT.

Nothing in this Order applies to or relates to the supply of aviation gasolene to the Government or instrumentality or authority of the Government.
