Customs Duty (Rebate) Act 1982

NOTICE OF REBATE

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 1 of the *Customs Duty* (*Rebate*) Act 1982 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, do hereby specify that there may be paid a rebate of import duty paid under the *Customs Tariff Act* (Chapter 102) or the *Customs (Tariff) Act* 1983 and that to the extent and in respect of the class of goods and class of persons and subject to the conditions and for the period all as set out in the Schedule.

#### SCHEDULE

(4) Class of goods and purpose for which used	Automotive diesel fuel consumed in powering the engine(s) or generator(s) of commercially operated marine vessels. "Automotive diesel fuel" is fuel falling under the tariff item 105.01 of the Schedule to the <i>Customs Tariff Act</i> (Chapter 102) and item 27.10.10 of Schedule 1 to the <i>Customs Tariff Act</i> 1983.
(b) Extent of rebate	Two toea per litre of duty-paid automotive diesel fuel consumed.
(c) Conditions	(1) The vessel which consumed the fuel forming the subject of the application for rebate must have been notified to Customs on the prescribed form prior to the purchase of the fuel, unless the fuel was purchased prior to 1st April, 1983, in which case completed notification must have been given to Customs before 1st May, 1983.
	(2) Rebates of duty on fuel consumed in vessels of over 10m. registered length will only be payable if the vessel was in survey at the time the fuel was consumed.
· ·	(3) Rebates of duty on fuel consumed in vessels of 10m. or lesser length will only be paid if the vessel was registered with the Department of Transport and Civil Aviation at the time the fuel was consumed.
(d) Class of person to whom payable	Citizens, companies incorporated in Papua New Guinea, registered business groups, Provincial Governments and Statutory Bodies who own, or are chartees of, and operate, a diesel-powered marine vessel engaged in commercial operations.
(e) Dates from which rebate will be allowable and payable	Subject to the various conditions being met, the rebate will be allowable on automotive diesel fuel purchased and consumed after 1st January, 1983, and will be payable after 1st April, 1983.

Rebates will be payable to a claimant not more than twice in any calendar year. Dated this 30th day of March, 1983.
