Co-operative Societies Act 1965

REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT OF REGISTRAR OF CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES

Whereas the Co-operative Societies Act 1965 was repealed by Companies (Co-operative Companies) Act 1975;

And whereas by Section 5 of the Companies (Co-operative Companies) Act 1975 the Co-operative Societies Act 1965 was deemed not to have been repealed for the purposes of the liquidation of co-operative societies the liquidation of which had commenced before the commencement of the Companies (Co-operative Companies) Act 1975;

And whereas it is necessary to appoint, from time to time, a person to exercise the powers and to perform the functions of Registrar in relation to the liquidation of those co-operative societies;

Now therefore I, Michael Thomas Somare, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Cooperative Societies Act 1965 and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of Memafu Malara as Registrar of Co-operative Societies dated 17th November, 1980 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G106 of 18th December, 1980; and
- (b) appoint Henry Heni Igo to be the Registrar of Co-operative Societies.
