

Organic Law on Provincial Government

REFERENCE TO NATIONAL FISCAL COMMISSION

THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 62 of the Organic Law on Provincial Government and all other powers it enabling, hereby refers to the National Fiscal Commission, for report, the matter of the increased retail sales tax on a carton of beer imposed by the Oro Provincial Government, on the grounds that the said retail sales tax is set at an unreasonably high level.
