Liquor (Licensing) Act (Chapter 312)

PROHIBITION OF SUPPLY OF LIQUOR

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 141 of the Liquor (Licensing) Act (Chapter 312) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby restrict the supply of liquor under a licence or permit throughout the National Capital District and Central Province for a period commencing on and from 8.00 a.m. on 7th May, 1984 up to 8.00 a.m. on 9th May, 1984, in accordance with the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Prohibit the supply of liquor under any licence or permit except by the holder of a publican's licence, limited hotel licence or restaurant licence who may supply liquor for consumption on the premises as part of a meal during the hours when such a licencee would ordinarily be permitted to supply liquor.
