SUBSTITUTION OF REDUCED RATE OF DUTY

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 8 of the *Customs Tariff Act* 1983 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby substitute, with effect from 1st May, 1983, in respect of the goods specified in Column 1 of the Schedule the reduced rate of duty specified in Column 2.
