REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF SECRETARY FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIVE INSTITUTIONS AND COMMISSIONER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES

  - (ii) Commissioner for Corrective Services;
- (b) appoint Matthew Jaran to act as Secretary for the Department of Corrective Institutions and Commissioner for Corrective Services.

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(2) of the Constitution and Section 16 of the *Broadcasting Commission Act* (Chapter 149) and all other powers me enabling me to act with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission and the Permanent Parliamentary Committee on Appointments, hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of Austin Sapias as Chairman of the National Broadcasting Board; and
- (b) appoint Kedeu Uru to be Chairman of that Board for a period of three years commencing on and from 22nd July, 1985.
