NOTIFICATION OF ZONING OF TOWN

GENERAL PRICES (AMENDMENT No. 71) ORDER 1983

being

A Prices Order to amend the General Prices Order 1983,

MADE by the Price Controller under the Prices Regulation Act (Chapter 320)—

- (a) in respect of all provisions except Section 1 to come into operation on the date of gazettal of this Order in the National Gazette; and
- (b) in respect of Section 1 to be deemed to have come into operation on 1st September, 1985.

1. REPEAL AND REPLACEMENT OF SECTION 15.

Section 15 of the Principal Order is repealed and replaced with the following:-

"15. MAXIMUM SCHEDULED AIRFARES.

The maximum airfares for services by an operator specified in Column 1 of Schedule 11 shall be the sum of the flag fall and the rate per kilometre of the journey specified in Columns 2 and 3, respectively, opposite the operator specified in Column 1.".

2. NEW SECTION 16.

The Principal Order is amended by adding at the end of Section 15 the following:-

- "16. NATIONAL CAPITAL DISTRICT LAND TRANSPORT FARES.
 - (1) In this section, unless the contrary intention appears—
 - "Category A Journey" means a journey between
 - (a) any two places in the Inner Zone; or
 - (b) any two places in the Outer Zone; or
 - (c) Boroko and any place in the Inner Zone; or
 - (d) Boroko and any place in the Outer Zone.
 - "Category B Journey" means a journey between a place in one zone and a place in another zone.
 - "Child" means person under the age of 14 years;
 - "Student" means person of 14 to 18 years of age inclusive in full time education, carrying an identification card showing the name of the school;
 - "Inner Zone" means the area comprising Baruni, Tatana, Kanudi, Idubada, Poreporena, Konedobu, Newtown, Port Moresby (Town), Koki, Badili, Kaugere, Gabutu, Matirogo, Vabukori, Pari, Sabama, Kilakila, Korobosea, Hohola, Two Mile Hill and Murray Barracks;
 - "Outer Zone" means the area comprising Gordon, Tokarara, Waigani, Morata, Gerehu, University Campus, Saraga, Jacksons Airport, Taurama Barracks, Moitaka, Erima, Five Mile, Six Mile, Arrow Bakery and Islander Hotel;
 - "Zone" means the Inner Zone or the Outer Zone.
 - (2) The Maximum National Capital District land transport fares by operators of public motor vehicles, for the class of persons specified in Column 1 of Schedule 12, shall be-
 - (a) in relation to services in Category A Journeys, the amount as specified in Column 2, and opposite the class of persons in Column 1; and
 - (b) in relation to services in Category B Journeys, the amount as specified in Column 3, and opposite the class of persons in Column 1.".
