Public Service Act (Chapter 67)

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF ACTING DEPARTMENTAL HEAD

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(3) of the Constitution and Section 121 of the *Public Service Act* (Chapter 67) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission, hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of Paul Bengo as Secretary, Department of Provincial Affairs; and
- (b) revoke the appointment of Frederick Haynes (who was appointed to act as Secretary until such time as the Secretary of the Department resumes duty) as Acting Secretary of the Department of Provincial Affairs; and
- (c) appoint Frederick James Lance Haynes to act as Secretary of the Department of Provincial Affairs for a period commencing on and from the date of signature of this instrument until such time a substantive appointment is made.

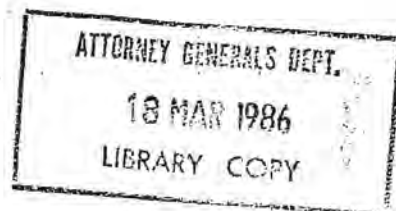
