## DECLARATION OF SPECIAL AREA

I, Tom Horik, Minister for Forests, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 13(1) of the Forestry Act (Chapter 216) and all other powers me enabling, hereby declare the Turama timber rights purchase area, details of which are specified in the Schedule, to be a special area for the purposes of that Act—

## SCHEDULE

An area of approximately 187 733 hectares known as Turama Timber Rights Purchase Area situated in the Milinch of Kanau south-west in the Fourmil of Kutubu, Milinch of Biwai north-west, north-east and south-east in the Fourmil of Aworra in the Kikori Sub-district of the Gulf Province commencing at the confluence of Komewu Creek and Turama River thence bounded upstream by the left bank of the said Komewu Creek for approximately 10 300 metres thence bounded due west for approximately 18 900 metres to the common Provincial Boundaries of Gulf and Western Provinces thence by the said common Provincial Boundary north-westerly and northerly for an approximate total distance of 72 400 metres to the common corner of Southern Highlands and the said Gulf and Western Provincial Boundaries thence bounded easterly by the common Provincial Boundary of the said Southern Highlands and Gulf Provinces for approximately 2 100 metres to the foot hill of the Great Papuan Plateau thence by the said foot hill generally south easterly for approximately 34 200 metres to the source of Hawoi River thence north-easterly by an unsurveyed line bearing approximately 73 degrees for 16 600 metres and 133 degrees 30 minutes for 13 300 metres to the foot hill aforesaid thence by the same foot hill generally south-easterly for approximately 24 000 metres thence southwesterly by an unsurveyed line bearing approximately 231 degrees for 4 400 metres to the right bank of Hawoi River aforesaid thence downstream by the said right bank of Hawoi River generally south-westerly for approximately 13 000 metres to its confluence with Turama River aforesaid thence by the left bank of the same Turama River upstream for approximately 14 400 metres to the point of commencement and be the several said dimensions a little more or a little less and all bearings magnetic.
