Industrial Relations Act (Chapter 174)

REFERENCE OF MATTER TO THE MINIMUM WAGES BOARD AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS

METHOD OF WAGE ADJUSTMENT OF ALL MINIMUM WAGES AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 10 and 14 of the *Industrial Relations Act* (Chapter 174) and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

- (a) appoint John Natera, Francis Kamuai, Napoleon Liosi, Meggen Zarriga, Tau Nana, Richard Joycey, to be Members of the Minimum Wages Board for the purposes set out in paragraph (b); and
- (b) refer to the Minimum Wages Board for determination the matters specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

TAKING into account current economic conditions and the future prospects for economic growth, and the continuing unemployment problem particularly among youth; and

BEARING in mind and future budgetary implications on the Nation's primary objectives of economic growth and employment creation, law and order, improvement of living standards in rural areas and equitable income distribution among all Papua New Guineans, the Government's stated intention to use the results of the 1988/89 Minimum Wages Board Determination as the basis for its subsequent Agreement with the Public Employees Association, and the impact the Board's Determination will have upon its ability to achieve its development objectives;

AND taking into account the need for orderly industrial relations and the desirability of attracting investment for development and expending the labour market;

THE BOARD is requested to address itself to, and determine the method of adjustment and commencement date and timing of such adjustments of all or some minimum wages over a period of three (3) years, and in particular;

- To review and determine the appropriateness or otherwise of the present method, formula and conditions
 for wage adjustments, as set out in Minimum Wages Board Determination No. 1 of 1986.
- 2. To review and determine the appropriateness or otherwise of the criteria for classifying Urban Level One and Urban Level Two Centres, for Minimum Wages Determination purposes.
- To review and determine the prospect of up-grading certain rural centres to Urban Level One or Level Two Centres based on 3.2 above.
- 4. To review and determine the prospect of up-grading certian Urban Level Two Centres to Urban Level One Centres under 3.2 above.
- To review and determine the appropriateness or otherwise of the current urban and rural minimum wage rates, aimed at introducing incentive schemes more succeptible to open market forces, whilst upholding the concept of minimum wages.
- To review and determine the appropriateness or otherwise of all previous Minimum Wages Board Determinations in respect of Camping Allowance, Heavy Duty Allowance, Rural Margin for Skills and Tool Allowance.
- 7. To consider the appropriateness and criteria for determining rural hardship allowance.
