PUBLIC NOTICE

I, Ignatius Kilage, G.C.M.G., C.B.E., K. St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council hereby:—

- (a) appoint Sunday, 16th and Monday, 17th September, 1990 respectively to be the days to commemorate the attainment by Papua New Guinea of Independent Sovereign Nationhood; and
- (b) appoint Monday, 18th June, 1990 to be the day to commemorate the birth of the Queen; and
