Land Act (Chapter 185)

LAND AVAILABLE FOR LEASING

A. APPLICANT:

Applicants or Tenderers should note-

1. Full name (block letters), occupation and address;

2. If a Company, the proper Registered Company name and address of the Company representative;

3. If more than one person, the tenancy desired and, if tenancy in common, the division of shares.

Applicants or tenderers should note-

4. That a lease cannot be held in a name registered under the Business Names Act only; and

5. That in the case of death in joint tenancy, the deceased partner's interest vests in the surviving partner and, in the case of tenancy in common, the deceased partner's interest vests in his estate.

B. TYPE OF LEASE:

Lease provided for are Business, Residence, Pastoral, Agricultural, Mission, Special Purposes and Town Subdivision Leases. With the exception of Town Subdivision Leases, State Leases may be granted for a maximum period of 99 years. Town Subdivision Leases have a maximum duration of 5 years.

Applicants should note that, in the case of town land the purpose of the lease must be in accordance with the zoning as declared under the *Town Planning Act.*

C. PROPOSED PURPOSES, IMPROVEMENTS, ETC:

The applicant or tenderer should provide fullest details (on attachment if necessary) of his proposal for the lease including information on-

- 2. Details of other land holdings in Papua New Guinea including approximate value of improvements to these holdings;

- 4. Experience and abilities to develop the land;
- 5. Any other details which would support the application.

D. DESCRIPTION OF LAND:

To be used only in NOT in response to an advertisement. A brief description giving area and locality is required. A sketch plan should be provided on an attachment. Where possible the land parcel should be identified on a map published by the Lands Department.

In the case of Tenders or an advertisement of land available for leasing the description is to be inserted in the column provided under the heading "Tender or Land Available Preference".

E. TENDER OF LAND A VAILABLE PREFERENCE:

The preference should be clearly indicated. In cases where there are more than 20 preferences the additional preferences may be shown on attachment. The "Description" should give the Lot and Section number or the Portion number as shown in the *Gazette*. The "Amount Offered" column need only be completed in the case of tenders.

F. TENDERERS:

Tenderers should take particular note that a tender for an amount less than the reserve price (being 60% of the unimproved value of the land) is invalid and shall not be considered. The successful tenderer will be required to pay the full amount of the tender.

G. TOWN SUBDIVISION LEASES:

In addition to the requirements of the relevant sections above, an applicant or tenderer for a Town Subdivision Lease shall submit:

(i) A preliminary proposal for the subdivision

(ii) A preliminary sketch plan of the proposed subdivision

(iii) Provisional proposals for subdivision surveys and installation of roads and drainage.






