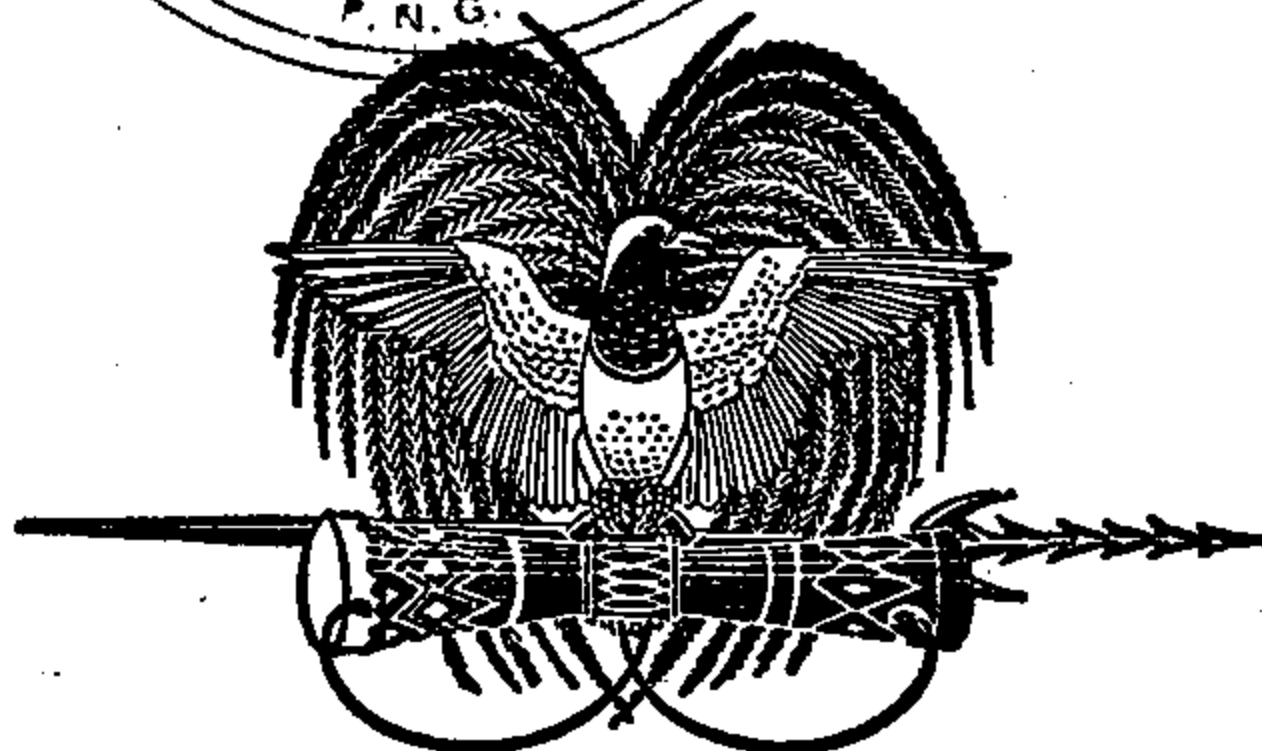

## PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW

I, Serei Eri, G.C.M.G., K. St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the *Curfew Act 1987* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby require every person within the boundaries of the town of Popondetta (being the boundaries specified in the Declaration of Town Boundaries of the Town of Popondetta published in the Papua New Guinea Gazette No. 65 of 7th December, 1967) in Northern Province to remain within doors between the hours of six o'clock in the evening (6 p.m.) and six o'clock in the morning (6 a.m.) for a period of two months commencing on and from six o'clock in the evening (6 p.m.) on Tuesday, 26th June, 1990.
