Physical Planning Act 1989

NOTIFICATION OF ZONING OF TOWN

The National Capital District Physical Planning Board, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 42 and 71 of the Physical Planning Act 1989 and all other powers it enabling, hereby gives notice of the zoning of town specified in the Schedule hereto and declares that each area depicted in plan as special use is a special use zone for the purpose of the Physical Planning Act 1989.

The zoning is specified in Column 2 of that Schedule to the town specified in Column 1 as depicted in plan or plans specified in Column 3.

Plans specified in this notice are available for inspection at the Department of Lands and Physical Planning, and at the offices specified in Column 4.

A person aggrieved by or who wishes to object to the declaration and division of a town zone by this notice, may within three (3) months after the date of the publication in the National Gazette of this, appeal to the Papua New Guinea Planning Appeals Tribunal.
