## Curfew Act 1987

## PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW

I, Serei Eri, G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Curfew Act 1987 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby require every person within the boundaries of National Capital District (being the boundaries specified in the Organic Law on the Boundaries of the National Capital District) to remain within doors between the hours of ten o'clock in the evening (10 p.m.) and five o'clock in the morning (5 a.m.) for a period of one month commencing on and from ten o'clock in the evening (10 p.m.) on Saturday 20th July, 1991.
