Bengo, a delegate of the Minister for Lands and Physical Planning by virtue of the powers under Land Act (Chapter 185) hereby enabling me to revoke Setting Aside over Allotment 3 Section 22, Town of Vanimo, West Sepik Province, to Department of Defence Force and the Australian Army Engineering is hereby deleted from Certificate of Occupancy Number 81 N.

The reason being that the subject land has already been Set Aside to Department of West Sepik Province on the 12th May, 1985 on Certificate of Occupancy Number 1589.
