REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF COMMANDER OF THE PAPUA NEW GUINEA DEFENCE FORCE

Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(3) of the Institution and Section 6 of the *Defence Act* (Chapter 74) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public services Commission hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of Robert Dademo as Commander of PNG Defence Force; and
- (b) appoint Tony Huai as Commander of PNG Defence Force for a period of three years,
